Please AS SOON AS POSSIBLE register and tell us your needs regarding boat weigh-in, sail measurements, shirt preferences, banquet attendance, and ask us questions. We will simplify much of the application process and provide you all the web resources you need to make your visit with us a success! Information packets by USPS are not planned.

Ordering Shirts: We hope you will enjoy our quality long-sleeve “Music City” CCR logo shirt, priced right. Please provide your size preferences as early as possible. I plan to order only once.

Sleep Accommodations: There are a variety of motels and hotels, plus a YMCA lodge, close to the race venue, ranging 3 to 7 miles from the marina. All driving is rapid with few lights.

Congestion should not be an issue unless you stay in downtown Nashville! Opryland Hotel is special. You are permitted to tent camp, RV park, or sleep-on-your-boat at the marina, which has basic shower and facilities (M and F), and BBQ grills and is ordinarily quiet.

Lunches: The Food Lion grocery is a convenient 3 miles from the marina and next-door to most of the motels, and their deli will take orders the night before. A Kroger’s is about 3 miles from the motels (about 6 miles from marina). We will not provide lunch boxes.

Trailers: You will park your trailer at the marina site on secure locked “loop” road.

Inspection: Upon arrival, you will be directed to a location where all your “boat stuff” will be removed, your boat inspected, weighed if necessary, and reloaded. Then you will have plenty of space to rig and you have two ramp options (no courtesy docks). Dockage should be easy and carts are available. Car parking is close. The marina is secure and has a militant guard 24/7. Vandalism has not been a problem.

Weigh-in: Serious economics surround weighing boats; planned potentially for 10/21 PM & 10/22 0800-1300. Tell us your needs in advance. We plan to provide a Weight Certificate to everyone present so entitled; after copies made, you’ll get your own.

Banquet: Planned to be at the American Legion #88, 2864 Elm Hill Pike, Donelson, TN 37214. Friday Night, an easy 5 miles from the marina. Menu pork and chicken. Buck-a-beer and priced right. I’m still working on this!

Dining: We encourage you to explore area restaurants; good sushi, Mexican, contemporary, within 6 miles of Marina. Ask us if you want our personal favorites in Nashville. *We will have “cookout” (dogs, burgers, chips & beer) on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday after the sailing.*
